2011 Electric Car Conversion Summer Workshop for Teachers July 25 – August 5, 2011

Come join other electric car enthusiasts as we once again convert a conventional gasoline burning vehicle over to clean, pollution free, electric power. No experience necessary! We will team up and create a vehicle that will never need to stop at a gas pump again! This year we will be converting a small truck, either an S-10 or Ranger.

This is a great class for auto shop instructors, college professors, science and math teachers, industrial and technology teachers, as well as anyone interested in the changing world of electric and hybrid cars. Each participant will get a copy of *Build Your Own Electric Vehicle* by Leitman and Brant, which gives a great background on how to convert a car. There will also be daily presentations on the various aspects of electric and hybrid cars, including battery technology, low-rolling resistance tires, biofuels and electric car performance.

Tuition is \$400 per workshop participant (includes breakfast, lunch and notebooks) Class begins on Monday, July 25th and ends on Friday, August 5th. The class runs Monday through Friday, both weeks, from 8:30 am to 3:30 pm each day. Breakfast and lunch are provided. **The workshop provides 20 hours of instructor training required for NATEF certified programs** (National Automotive Technical Education Foundation). A certificate of completion will be awarded to all attendees at the end of the workshop.
